## Home Assignment! June 2009

We were in the US during March and April on what used to be called **"furlough"** but is now more accurately termed **Home Assignment**. Missionaries often are as busy when they take a trip home as they are on field. We visited several supporting churches to give updates and some new churches to present our ministry. We also were part of our home church' week long mission conference where we were involved or presenting several times each day. While back home we were often reminded of the need for the Christian counseling ministry. We had opportunities to provide counsel and guidance for several missionaries and other Christian workers. It seemed that God was confirming this ministry in many ways while on *Home Assignment!*

Often in ministry we don't get to see the long term results of our work and witnessing. That will only be realized at the Judgment Seat of Christ. However, ***sometimes God gives us a little glimpse of the fruit of our labors to encourage us.*** During our time in the states, and since return to France, we received several testimonies and some e-mails from people that we have been able to help over the years and are still in the ministry. We give thanks to the Lord for using us and to you for your prayers and faithfulness. You have enabled us to be here to help missionaries in their time of need keeping them on the field serving the Lord.

### FRUIT THAT REMAINS AS THE WORK CONTINUES

Within a week of arriving back in France we were counseling and caring for a single missionary lady here in Europe. She expressed her thanks that someone was available on short notice to help. Then a missionary pastor and his wife facing difficult circumstances came to stay with us for a week of counseling. More missionaries are scheduled in the next few weeks. Please keep these servants and us in your prayers as we continue to minister here knowing that ***we are helpless without His wisdom, grace and power!***
