## Transition time for Morykons

This spring has been a difficult time for our family. In late while still in France, both of our fathers unexpectedly passed away within two weeks of each other and we returned home for their funerals. In addition my mother (Susan) is currently in hospital facing removal of a cancerous tumor in her colon. My mother age 88, is in need of family assistance and so we are moving her to Virginia from Georgia to be closer to family. Through much prayer and consultation with our home (senior) church and mission board, we have made a decision to remain in the US to help while continuing our ministry of missionary care from here. ***Our church and mission board are working with us as we make this transition.***

***In this new phase of ministry, I will be working with mission boards and missionaries here. We will also continue to travel to where missionaries live and work overseas to provide counseling and consultation to them and at conferences where missionaries meet.*** There have been several requests for this already. We have seen several missionaries for counseling since returning. We also are ***recruiting others*** to continue the work of establishing and operating missionary care centers in Europe, Asia, Africa, a throughout the world. On July 9th I am interviewing a couple who wants to join our overseas team.

The eventual transition to a counseling, training, and recruiting ministry based in the US had been the future plan from the beginning. I have been a counselor for twenty five years and in the sixth decade of life now. The experience we have gained the past seven years has been invaluable in our work and we are just making this transition a little sooner than expected.

***We understand that for our churches and individual supporters this is a change in ministry location and a slightly different role since we were first approved for support.*** We trust the Lord that that your support will continue strongly behind us so that I can continue this ministry and the important work of missionary care worldwide. I am contacting each of our churches and supporters to discuss this transition.
