If these missionaries have to leave the field, the people among whom they are working could have no other contact with the gospel – no other hope of hearing God's offer of forgiveness through His Son, Jesus Christ!

What could be a better or more responsible use of God's resources? Thank you for supporting us with your prayers and sacrificial gifts which are impacting the lives and ministries of hundreds of Christian workers every year.
